The Minister of Local Government and Planning in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by subsection (3) of Section 28 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, hereby confirms the above Order, subject to the following modifications:-


- 1. In paragraph 2, after the words "map annexed hereto" there shall be inserted the words "excluding such portions of the said areas as are hatched black on the said map".
- 2. In sub paragraph (2)(c) of paragraph 7 the word "part" shall be substituted for the word "trees".
- 3. At the end of paragraph 8 there shall be added the words "except where such reference occurs in the expressions 'entitled to fell trees' and 'entitled to fell the trees' ".

SECOND SCHEDULE.

his Order shall not apply so as to require the consent of the authority

- the cutting down, topping or lopping of any tree that is dying or dead or has become dangerous,
- the cutting down, topping or lopping of any [tree] Perotip of trees], [woodland area].
 - (a) in compliance with an obligation imposed by or under an Act of Parliament;
 - (b) in pursuance of the power conferred on the Postmaster-General by virtue of Section 5 of the Telegraph (Construction) Act, 1908;
